

Thank you for the support with this. We are working very hard to generate funding for the different projects in the areas around the building which have evolved as the project has evolved over the year to date.

Features of this latest iteration feature additional garden and planting work, more seating and an artificial all weather sports surface playing area which has doubled in size while retaining a natural grass lawn area.

The clay and Lego bricks will be available until **October** unless sold out before that. Our fundraising target is \$25 000 including funds from the many different grants we have applied to.




- 1. Engraved red clay bricks in the outdoor area paving.

Current and past students, parents and all whānau across the country and world, supporters of Kilbirnie School, organisations and of course all local businesses are invited.






