Frequently Asked Questions

1. Engraved red clay bricks in the outdoor area paving.

Q. How much are the bricks including engraving?

A. \$150.

Q. The \$150 for the bricks is a donation – is this tax deductible?

A. Yes. Please tick the box on the order form if you would like to you receive a receipt.

Q. How many characters can I have on one brick?

A. A maximum 16 characters including spaces on each line. A maximum of 3 lines.

Q. Can we order more than one brick?

A. Absolutely! Order forms can be emailed to the office at any time. These can be downloaded from the school website or a hard copy is available from the office. One order form per brick.

Q. Do I get to keep my brick?

A. The bricks will all form part of the permanent paving on the West side of the new Whātaimai Hub.

Q. What size are the bricks?

A. Full size red clay bricks.

2. **Engraved Lego bricks as part of a wall inside the building.**

Q. How much are the bricks including engraving?

A. \$35.

Q. The \$35 for the bricks is a donation – is this tax deductible?

A. Yes. Please tick the box on the order form if you would like to you receive a receipt.

Q. How many characters can I have on one brick?

A. A maximum of 20 characters including spaces.

Q. Can we order more than one brick? For example, one for each of our children.

A. Absolutely! You can order as many as you like. Each form allows you to order 1-4 bricks.

Q. Do I get to keep my brick?

A. The bricks will all form part of a permanent wall within the new Whātaïtai Hub.

Q. What size are the bricks?

A. The bricks are normal Lego, 2 x 8 (2 high x 2 wide x 8 long) which is double the length of a 'standard' Lego brick. They measure 64mm x 9mm x 15mm.

Q. Can I choose the colour of my brick, where my brick goes, or whose brick is next to mine?

A. Unfortunately not. The architects have designed the panel to fit the Whātaïtai Hub colour scheme.

Q. Am I able to put my own design on the brick, choose a font, or the colour of the print?

A. Unfortunately not. The bricks will have standard writing on them. Any words that use English letters are fine provided there are a maximum of 20 characters. We will work with the architects and the engraver to select the most appropriate font.

Q. When will I be able to see my brick?

A. As soon as the Whātaïtai hub is open.

Q. Is this sponsored by Lego?
