- Mrs Patel's Homeroom (Year 0-1)
- Rachel's Homeroom (Year 1-2)
- Mrs Mudge's Homeroom (Year 1-2)

Learning Studio

The Junior Learning Studio was completed in 2011 and is home to the Ngake Hub. The layout of the building is designed with flexible, innovative learning environments which allow teachers to co-teach, drawing on each other's strengths. Rooms are equipped with technology that enable a modern teaching practice.

Students who begin their schooling from Kindy/Preschool start in Mrs Patel's Homeroom. Students starting school in the first half of the year, up to June 30, begin school as a Year 1, moving into Year 2 the following year. Students who start school during the second half of the year, after July 1, begin as a Year 0. These students move into Year 1 at the start of the following year.

As the roll continues to grow in the New Entrant class, groups of students who are deemed socially, emotionally and academically ready will be transitioned into a Year 1-2 class in consultation with parents. All rooms open onto a shared learning space, so there is plenty of opportunity for cross grouping and shared learning to take place within the hub.
